Installation

- 1. Connect wires to 3-12VDC supply in accordance with local and national code.
- 2. Secure fixture to junction box with hardware provided.

NOTE: This remote lamp is constant power and should match to specified emergency battery backup equipment recommended by the manufacturer. If used with other manufacturer's emergency unit, a test should be performed to confirm discharge time in advance.
